I am happy to report that over this past month, we've supplied adequate, dry, secure shelter for 2 deserving families.

The first, in mid-October, was for a family of 6. Total weekly income: \$63 USD. The oldest child, Lorena, 10, had never slept in a bed. Their completed home is pictured at right but I've posted a YouTube video of their living conditions beforehand:
